**MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE:** Robert Lindsey, Carol Huff, Mayor Harold Goffinet, Clerk-Treasurer Susie Roberts and City Attorney, John Hargis.

**PLEDGE:** The *Pledge of Allegiance* was said by all.

**MINUTES APPROVAL:** Robert made a motion to approve the minutes of our regular meeting on June 3rd; Carol seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.

**WASTEWATER REPORT:** Sherry Roeder gave the wastewater report (see attached report).

**PROPERTY CLEAN-UP:** The following properties need cleaned up and/or mowed: **319 S 8<sup>th</sup> St**-needs mowed; **720 Jefferson St**-property grown up with vegetation and door will not close, we will file a complaint; **709 N 7<sup>th</sup> St**-grass needs mowed; **338 S 6<sup>th</sup> St**-dead limbs in the yard; **335 S 6<sup>th</sup> St**-grass needs mowed, limbs in yard, car in the back yard; **421 Main St**-needs mowed; **Trailer Park at 826 N Lincoln Avenue, Lots #1, #5, #16**, trash bags need to be removed **#18**, door open **and #20**, needs to be mowed; **620 Williamson St**-property is in bankruptcy but mortgage company has it on their list to clean up.
