

**ROCKPORT BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS
JULY 7, 2015 5:00 PM**

MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE: Robert Lindsey, Connie Hargis, Mayor Harold Goffinet, Clerk-Treasurer Susie Roberts and City Attorney, Bryan Rudisill.

PLEDGE: The *Pledge of Allegiance* was said by all.

MINUTES APPROVAL: Robert made a motion to approve the minutes of our previous meeting; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.

WASTEWATER REPORT: Sherry Roeder gave the wastewater report (see attached report).

SIGN TAP ON AGREEMENTS: Tap on agreements were signed.

STREET SIGN AT PLEASANT GROVE (COBBLEFIELD DR): Attorney Bryan Rudisill stated that the street identification signage would be the responsibility of the developer. However, any traffic control signage would be the responsibility of the city. It was decided to post speed limit signage in the sub-division.

SIDEWALK REPAIRS: The sidewalk at South Eighth Street and Seminary is in need of repair. Also, the sidewalk on S Third St needs repair.

PROPERTY CLEAN UP: **115 S Fourth St**-needs mowed; **806 Eureka Rd**-mowed once but needs it again, as well as the lot next to it; **615 Washington**-letter was sent but property was not mowed-we will mow it and place a lien on the property; **714 Washington**-notify Bryan Rudisill with a date trash will be hauled off so he can notify property owner; **338 S Sixth**-this is scheduled for a sheriff's sale.

OLD BUSINESS: Utility Clerk, Andrea Lester, appeared before the board to discuss the possibility of upgrading our water meter system. The meters we are currently using are now obsolete and we will have to start using a different meter. The proposed meters could give us an hourly reading-if necessary. This would potentially help the property owner in the event of a high read. Robert made a motion to take this before the council; Connie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion was approved.
