Rutherford County EMS is excited to offer our citizens a unique service to better their overall health. Our Community Paramedic focuses on citizens with chronic illness or those who need assistance connecting resources so they can get the health care they need. Our Community Paramedic makes scheduled, house calls to check up on patients, explains discharge instructions if they've had a recent hospital stay, makes sure all medications are filled, locates resources such as transportation, and performs blood pressure or glucose checks, if needed.
