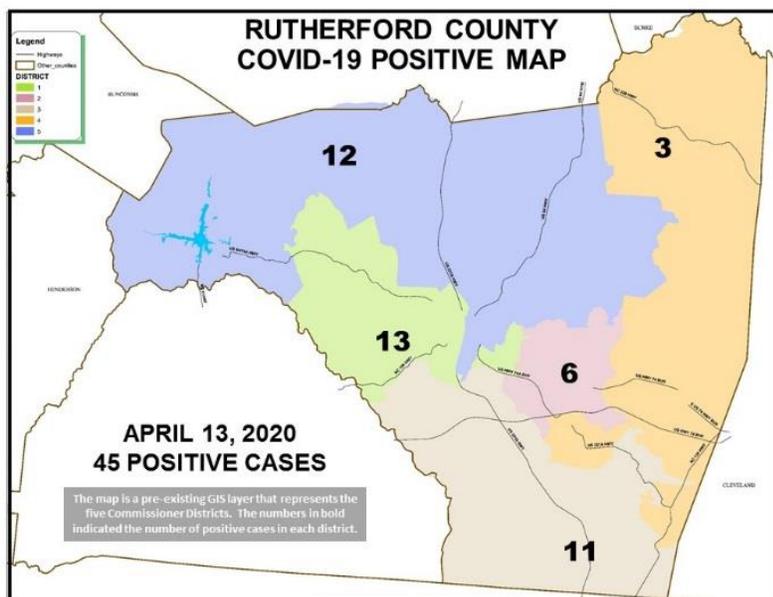
04-13-2020: COVID-19 UPDATE

Rutherford County Health Department and the Rutherford County Emergency Operations Center, posts daily updates on testing numbers to keep the public informed of the impact of the virus on the community. Today's daily update is as follows:

- 382 individuals tested
- 320 tests are negative
- 17 tests are pending
- 45 tests are positive which includes 2 deaths
