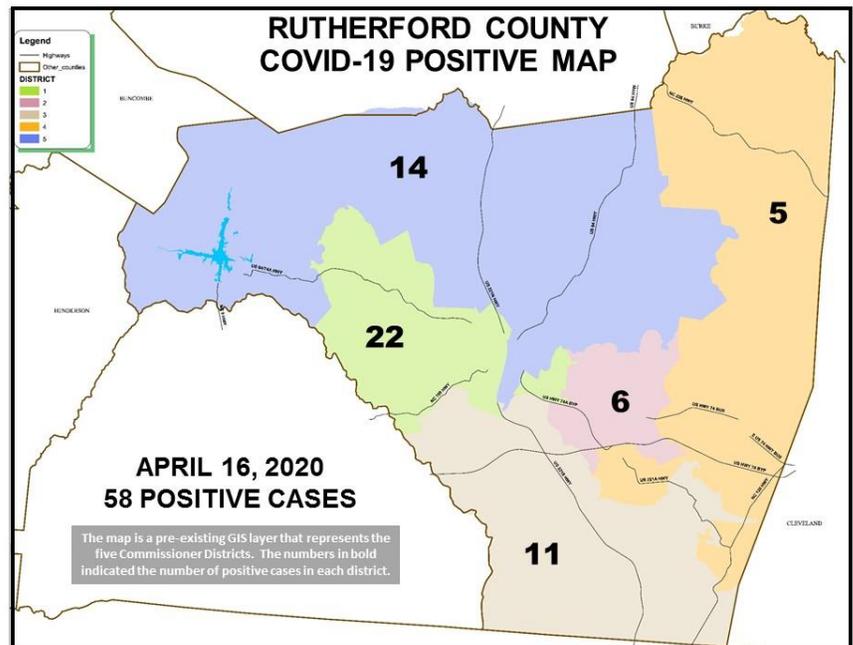

04-16-2020: COVID-19 UPDATE

Rutherford County Health Department and the Rutherford County Emergency Operations Center, posts daily updates on testing numbers to keep the public informed of the impact of the virus on the community. Today's daily update is as follows:

- 485 individuals tested
- 355 tests are negative
- 72 tests are pending
- 58 tests are positive which includes 2 deaths

As more positive tests are returned from the labs, the more contact tracing the Health Department conducts. This inevitability results in additional positive tests because many of the people being tested through contact tracing live in the same household as the current positive case.
