There have been zero positive cases of COVID-19 in Rutherford County.

- 112 individuals tested
- 66 tests are negative
- 46 tests are pending
- 0 tests are positive

Rutherford County issued a Stay at Home Order which went into effect this morning at 6:00 am. To read the full order go to rutherfordcountync.gov and click on the Covid-19 box. Our local Public Health Director, Karen Powell stated today a great reminder to us all, "The virus doesn't move. People do. If we stay still it will die." We are urging citizens to please stay at home.
