

**ORDINANCE NO. 21-010**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, FOR REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION ON CITY PROPERTY FOR THE PERIOD OF MARCH 1, 2021, THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2022; AND DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE IMMEDIATE EFFECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 14 OF THE CITY CHARTER.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission authorized and directed the City Manager to enter into a contract with Republic Services of Sandusky, Ohio, for refuse / recycling collection on City property for the period of March 1, 2019, through February 28, 2021, by Ordinance No. 19-036, passed on February 25, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, upon public competitive bidding as required by law one (1) appropriate bid was received, and the bid of Republic Services of Sandusky, Ohio, was determined to be the lowest and best bid; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed contract involves the pickup of dumpsters and totes spread over five (5) zones in the City for the period of March 1, 2021, through February 28, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of the services is \$9,197.26 per month from April 1<sup>st</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup> and \$2,331.84 per month from November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup> for a total cost of \$76,040.02; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance should be passed as an emergency measure under suspension of the rules in accordance with Section 14 of the City Charter in order to execute the contract with Republic Services which begins on March 1, 2021, and prevent any interruption of the services currently being provided; and

**WHEREAS**, in that it is deemed necessary in order to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety of the City of Sandusky, Ohio, and its citizens, and to provide for the efficient daily operation of the Municipal Departments, including the Department of Public Services, of the City of Sandusky, Ohio, the City Commission of the City of Sandusky, Ohio finds that an emergency exists regarding the aforesaid, and that it is advisable that this **Ordinance** be declared an emergency measure which will take immediate effect in accordance with Section 14 of the City Charter upon its adoption; and NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Republic Services of Sandusky, Ohio, for refuse and recycling collection on City property and disposal services for the period of March 1, 2021, through February 28, 2022, in an amount **not to exceed** Seventy Six Thousand Forty and 02/100 Dollars (\$76,040.02) consistent with the bid submitted by Republic Services of Sandusky, Ohio, currently on file in the office of the Director of Public Services.

Section 2. If any section, phrase, sentence, or portion of this Ordinance is

for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3. This City Commission finds and determines that all formal actions of this City Commission concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this City Commission and that all deliberations of this City Commission and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 4. That for the reasons set forth in the preamble hereto, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure which shall take immediate effect in accordance with Section 14 of the City Charter after its adoption and due authentication by the President and the Clerk of the City Commission of the City of Sandusky, Ohio.
