

ELIZABETH TITUS MEMORIAL LIBRARY  
KINDLE POLICY

Elizabeth Titus Memorial Library cardholders, 16 years and older, and in good standing (fines less than \$5.00) may borrow Kindle e-readers from the circulation desk on a first-come, first-served basis. **The Kindles may not be reserved in advance.**

Borrowers can check out the Kindle for a period of 2 weeks. A \$5 per day fine will be assessed for Kindles not returned when their time has expired.

The individual checking out the Kindle is responsible for it and all of its accessories while checked out in their name. The Kindle must be returned to the circulation desk in person. The borrower will be required to wait until the staff verifies the equipment is in proper working order. Returning the Kindle to the drop box will result in a \$20 fine and loss of future checkout privileges.

The Borrower will be billed for a lost or damaged Kindle or any of its accessories. Replacement cost depends on the model borrowed and the replacement cost at the time of replacement. The library will make all purchases of replacement equipment or accessories.
