ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 – ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT, ARTICLE II,
SECTION 11-2-2 - ELECTRIC SERVICE AND CODES OF THE REVISED CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SULLIVAN, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and City Council of the City of Sullivan, Moultrie County, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1: CHAPTER 11 – ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT, Article II – Electric System Regulations, Section 11-2-2 shall be amended to read as follows:

11-2-2 ELECTRIC SERVICE AND CODES.

(A) **Service Rejected or Terminated.**

- (1) The City Line Foreman shall have the right to reject any application for service or to terminate service to any customer whose premises, in the judgement of the City Line Foreman, is dangerous to persons or are otherwise unsafe in the vicinity of the City's meter and other facilities.
- (2) Failure to reject an application for the service or the commencement of service by the City Line Foreman shall not constitute an omission, acknowledgement or agreement, either expressed or implied, as to the adequacy safety or other characteristics of any installation on the customer's premises not owned or maintained by the City.

(B) **Adoption of National Codes.** The City adopts the requirements of the most recent additions of the National Electrical Code (NEC NFPA 70) and the National Electric Safety Code (NEC ANSI C2) and requires all applicants and contractors to conform to these National Codes.

(C) **Adoption of Electric Service Manual.** The City adopts the installation requirements and guidelines of the Ameren Electric Service Manual, a current copy of which is found at the following online address: <https://www.ameren.com/-/media/corporate-site/files/servicemanual/amerenelectric/servicemanual.pdf?la=en&hash=15A64C37258838E40028B3FAD69D71BDAD573802> and requires all applicants and contactors to conform to its guidelines.

SECTION 2: All previous ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 20-19.
