ORDINANCE NO. 20-18

AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 21 of the “Municipal Code, City of Sullivan, Illinois,” as amended.

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan, Moultrie County, Illinois, is a duly established and functioning municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan has reviewed the regulation of alcoholic beverages within the City of Sullivan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan deems it appropriate to further regulate the subject of alcoholic beverages within the City of Sullivan to further the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Sullivan;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SULLIVAN, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1:

That Section 21-1-1 of Chapter 21 of the “Municipal Code, City of Sullivan, Illinois,” as amended, is hereby amended to include the following additional definitions in the appropriate alphabetical placement with the already listed definitions:

“BASSET” means Beverage Alcohol Sales and Servers Education Training.

“BASSET CERTIFICATE” means a certificate, card, or other written evidence issued by a person or entity that is licensed, certified, or otherwise duly authorized by the State of Illinois Liquor Control Commission to offer a BASSET program and to issue such certificates, cards, or other written evidence of successful completion of a BASSET program, as required by 235 ILCS 5/3-12(11.1) and 6-27 and Title 77 of the Illinois Administrative Code, Chapter XVI, Section 3500.

Section 2:

That Section 21-3-20 of Chapter 21 of the “Municipal Code, City of Sullivan, Illinois,” as amended, is further hereby amended in its entirety to now read as follows:

“21-3-20 **PERSONS SELLING LIQUOR.** It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to attend any bar or to sell, draw, pour or mix any alcoholic liquor in any Class “A” licensed retail premises except as specifically stated herein. In a Class “B”, “C”, or “D” licensed business, a person may serve if he is eighteen (18) years of age or older. (See 235 ILCS Sec. 5/4-1)

Notwithstanding the foregoing, individuals employed by a licensee with a Class B or Class D license who are at least eighteen (18) years of age and under twenty-one (21) years of age may handle alcoholic liquor in a container that has the original packaging or seal unbroken and may sell packaged alcoholic liquor. For the purpose of this section, "sell" shall mean taking orders for the sale of alcoholic liquor, delivering alcoholic liquor, taking money for the purchase of alcoholic liquor or ringing such a sale on a cash register. Individuals between the ages of 18 and 21 may not “tend bar” and shall not deliver alcoholic beverages across the bar. Individuals between the ages of 18 and 21 may only handle, sell, or deliver alcoholic beverages under the supervision of the manager or owner of the premises, who must be on the premises and in addition to the individual between the ages of 18 and 21, said manager or owner shall be responsible for compliance with this Section and shall be subject to any applicable prosecutions for violation of this Code and/or regulations or statutes of the State of Illinois.

Any individual between the ages of 18 and 21 handling, selling, or delivering alcohol pursuant to this section, and any manager or owner supervising such an individual must successfully complete a State of Illinois Liquor Control Commission licensed or certified BASSET training program within thirty (30) days after the server begins serving alcohol for any licensee. Each person must maintain their BASSET certificate in good standing at all times he/she is engaged in handling, selling or delivering alcoholic liquor. A BASSET certificate is the property of the individual and the individual shall be entitled to take his or her BASSET certificate with him or her should he or she change employment with one (1) licensee to another licensee. An individual shall not sell, assign, or otherwise transfer his or her BASSET certificate to any other person. An individual must produce his or her BASSET certificate upon request of any law enforcement officer, the Sullivan liquor control commissioner, or a representative of the State of Illinois Liquor Control Commission. A licensee shall assure that its servers have valid BASSET certificates where required, obtain and retain a copy of each server's BASSET certificate on the licensee's premises and make available for inspection copies of all server's BASSET certificates upon request of any law enforcement officer, the Sullivan liquor control commissioner, or a representative of the State of Illinois Liquor Control Commission. Section 3: That except as detailed above, all other Ordinances of the City of Sullivan shall retain their current language and remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: That the City Clerk of the City of Sullivan, Illinois be and is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the Statutes of the State of

Illinois, made and provided.

Section 5: That should any part of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.

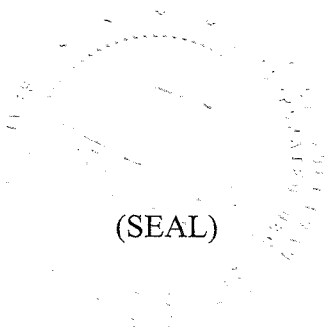
