

**RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS**

**Resolution No. 20-H**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sullivan, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois competitive public infrastructure application,


WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Sullivan to undertake the project to construct a new 1.5 MGD Water Treatment Plant.

WHEREAS, criteria are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with local public funds and other funds (endowment), as needed.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Sullivan does hereby commit funds from City of Sullivan Local Public Funds in the amount of \$2,923,500 and other funds (Sullivan Chamber & Economic Endowment) in the amount of \$76,500 for use in conjunction with a Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant, such funds to equal 37.5% of the estimated total project cost of \$8,000,000, or \$3,000,000.

PASSED and APPROVED at its regular City Council Meeting, held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020.
