Funding Support for Cycle 14
Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program Grant Project

WHEREAS: the Sullivan City Council wants to support streetscape improvement projects that create a safe designated route for pedestrian and alternative non-motorized traffic to key points within the City of Sullivan, encourage healthy lifestyles, and boost economic development; and

WHEREAS: the Council is committed to the completion of the Phase 5 Streetscape Improvement project to improve existing facilities by making them more accommodating and/or accessible for pedestrian and alternative non-motorized transportation use. The project is a continuation of transportation enhancement projects that allow for safe designated routes for pedestrian and alternative non-motorized traffic; and

WHEREAS: the Council understands that the streetscape improvements will provide worthwhile benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Sullivan apply for a \$1,395,594 grant from the Cycle 14 Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program and support the project by providing the required local match with \$348,899 in funding or donations as defined under the Federal Flexible Match Program.
