

Resolution 21-U

A Resolution Establishing Electric Vehicle (EV) Incentive Program

WHEREAS, the City of Sullivan (“the City”) is a duly established municipal corporation in Moultrie County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City has studied the increased usage of Electric Vehicles and wishes to encourage electric vehicle charging within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Energy Agency (IMEA) has established an Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station Incentive program which provides grants to communities establishing Electric Vehicle Charging Stations and the City anticipates further similar grants to become available in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to take advantage of available grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City deems this Resolution necessary and helpful for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City;

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sullivan, Moultrie County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: An Electric Vehicle (EV) Incentive Program is hereby established within the corporate limits of the City of Sullivan to assist qualified applicants with the purchase and installation of EV Charging Stations for public and private use.

SECTION 2: Applications for incentive funding shall be executed by the owner(s) of the subject property in written or online forms made available at City Offices or online at the City's website www.sullivanil.us.

SECTION 3: Administration of the incentive program including review and approval of applications shall be conducted by the designee of the Council in accordance with specific written guidelines which shall be published on the City website and also made available in written form at the City Building at 2 West Harrison Sullivan, Illinois 61951.

SECTION 4: Any property owner whose application is denied shall have the right to appeal the Council's designee's decision directly to the City Council by requesting addition to the agenda for a subsequent regular meeting of the City Council. The City Council's decision on any such appeal shall be final.

SECTION 5: Grants shall only be awarded subject to funding available from the municipal electric department's wholesale electric provider, the Illinois Municipal Electric Agency. Initially, the maximum award per grant application shall not exceed \$200 for private EV charging stations and \$500 for public EV charging stations. In every instance request for payment shall be supported by the provision of paid receipts evidencing

payment in full for purchase and installation of an eligible charging station and dated between January 1, 2019 and April 30, 2022. After April 30, 2022 this program will only allow installations to be approved that fall in the Fiscal Year at the time the application is submitted and the maximum grant award may change at the beginning of each fiscal year as the program matures. These changes shall be published on the City website and also made available in written form at the City Building 2 West Harrison Sullivan, IL 61951.

SECTION 6: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
