The Mayor and City Council met at 7:30 PM on Wednesday, June 5, 2019 in the City Council Chambers.

Sustainable Communities Application – Acting City Manager Wieprecht explained that authorization is needed to sign the application to submit to the Department of Housing and Community Development.

Introduction:

Ordinance 07 – 2019 – Amendment to Taneytown Zoning code – Attorney Gullo explained that the ordinance would define a use entitled Adult Entertainment Activity and create an overlay zone for placement in the Restricted Industrial District, designate alcoholic beverage package stores as a permitted use in the Downtown Business District and designate Tattoo Studios as a permitted use in the General Business District.
