

Absentee Ballot requests

On March 13, 2023 the Absentee Ballot Request form will be available online, however there are certain factors to consider:

- The request form must be mailed to 17 E. Baltimore Street, Taneytown, MD 21787
- Voters must allow time for the original paper ballot to be mailed to their address and then time for the ballot to be mailed back to our office.

To avoid potential delays, the ballot can be placed in the sealed return envelope and placed in the secure drop box at City Hall, which is emptied every morning.

- Beginning April 10, 2023, Absentee Ballots will be mailed to voters who completed a request form and voters can also stop by City Hall during the hours of 8:00 and 4:00 to complete the request form and receive the paper ballot in person. Voters can then make their selections and submit the ballot immediately.
