Item #1 - The Special Meeting of the Public Works Committee was called to order at 7:19 p.m.

Item #2 – CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL PUBLIC WORKS

COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 2, 2018 – Motion was made by Chairman Younker, seconded by Trustee Glotz, to approve the minutes of the Special Public Works Committee meeting held on October 2, 2018. Vote by voice call. Chairman Younker declared the motion carried.

Item #3 – DISCUSS PARKWAY TREE PLANTING PROGRAM – SUBURBAN TREE

CONSORTIUM – The Suburban Tree Consortium (STC) is an intergovernmental agreement established by its members to contract and negotiate with nurseries and tree planting services to provide its members with a variety of quality trees at reasonable prices. Options include a 5-year contractual program or a seasonal bid program. The 5-year contractual program allows municipalities to project their needs 5 years ahead and trees will be grown specifically for that municipality. The seasonal bid program allows municipalities to bid as a group each spring and fall to provide budgetary flexibility each year, while benefiting from the savings of a joint purchase.

Joining the STC requires adopting a resolution to agree to the bylaws of the consortium, which requires mayoral approval and Village Board approval, as well as an annual membership fee of \$575.

Staff recommended the Village of Tinley Park to pursue joining the Suburban Tree Consortium given high-quality goods, low-mortality rate and reasonable pricing for the Parkway Tree Planting program.

Motion was made by Chairman Younker, seconded by Trustee Brady, to recommend placing Parkway Tree Planting program on the agenda for the next Village Board meeting. Vote by voice. Chairman Younker declared the motion carried.

<u>Item #4 – DISCUSS CONTRACT AWARD OF ROAD SALT FOR 2018-2019</u> – A request for a purchasing agreement proposal for bulk rock salt was requested from a total of nine (9) companies. Proposals were received from Morton Salt for \$87.45 per ton and Chicago Salt for \$106.00 per ton.

Funding for bulk salt is available in the Road and Bridge and Commuter Parking Lot Operating and Maintenance Funds of \$357,500,000.

Staff recommended purchase agreement approval with Morton Salt for the FY-19 bulk salt purchase in the amount of \$87.45 per ton at a cost not to exceed \$480,975.00.

Motion was made by Chairman Younker, seconded by Trustee Glotz, to recommend placing Contract Award of Road Salt for 2018-2019 on the agenda for the next Village Board meeting. Vote by voice. Chairman Younker declared the motion carried.

<u>Item #5 – DISCUSS CONTRACT AWARD – RENEWAL CUL-DE-SACS SNOW REMOVAL</u> - A service contract for snow removal was advertised on September 12, 2017, in accordance with state bidding laws. Eight (8) contractors reviewed the contracts and two (2) sealed bids were received. The contract includes pricing for two (2) optional contract extensions of 1 year each, which may be approved at the sole discretion of the Village. Bids opened and read publicly on October 3, 2017 at 2:05 p.m. include Zenere Trucking & Excavating of \$134,298.36 and Tovar of \$234,112.00.

Funding for Renewal Cul-de-sacs Snow Removal is available in the approved FY-19 Budget, Operations and Maintenance funds in the amount of \$225,000.00.

Staff recommended approval of the service contract renewal with Zenere Trucking & Excavating for the FY-19 Cul-de-sacs Snow Removal Contract in the amount of \$134,298.36.

Trustee Glotz asked if the snow removal price increased from last year and K. Mulqueeny, Street Superintendent stated it did not increase from last year.

Motion was made by Chairman Younker, seconded by Trustee Brady, to recommend placing Contract Award - Renewal Cul-de-Sacs Snow Removal on the agenda for the next Village Board meeting. Vote by voice. Chairman Younker declared the motion carried.

Item #6 – DISCUSS CONTRACT AWARD – PARKING LOT SNOW REMOVAL – A service contract for parking lot snow removal was advertised on September 10, 2018, in accordance with state bidding laws. Seven (7) contractors reviewed the contracts and three (3) sealed bids were received. This contract includes pricing for two (2) optional contract extensions of 1 year each, which may be approved at the sole discretion of the Village. Bids opened and read publicly on September 26, 2018 at 2:05 p.m. include Beverly Snow & Ice, Inc. of \$100,350.00; Arctic Snow & Ice of \$175,770.00 and Tovar of \$431,475.00.

Funding for Parking Lot Snow Removal is available in the approved FY-19 Budget, Operations and Maintenance funds in the amount of \$342,720.00.

Staff recommended approval of the service contract with Beverly Snow & Ice, Inc. for year 1 of 3 for Parking Lot Snow Removal in the amount of \$100,350.00.

Motion was made by Chairman Younker, seconded by Trustee Brady, to recommend placing Contract Award – Parking Lot Snow Removal (year 1 of 3) on the agenda for the next Village Board meeting. Vote by voice. Chairman Younker declared the motion carried.

<u>Item #7 – RECEIVE COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC</u> - No comments from the public.

Trustee Brady stated pink patches to support breast cancer awareness throughout October are available for purchase at the Tinley Park Police Department for \$10.

Presented for November 6th, 2018 Special Public Works Committee and Village Board Agenda discussion and possible action:

Description:

At the June 12th, 2018 Village Board meeting, a contract was awarded to Meade Electric in the amount of \$214,438.97 for the LED Street Lighting Replacement - Phase 2 Project. Public Works has completed Phase One of the LED Street Lighting Replacement Project in FY 2017, which included approximately 400 street lights. We are currently completing Phase Two which consist of approximately 254 street lights but this proposed change order will add 123 additional street lights to the Phase Two Project (Including pole covers and fuse kits).

Background:

Work consists of the removal and replacement of street lighting luminaires within the specified areas as presented in the details of the contract documents. Scope of work includes demolition and removal of existing HID type fixtures, verification that existing materials are up to current electrical code standards, necessary repairs and replacement of luminaire with specified LED type fixture. The work also includes related repairs as necessary to complete the work. Public Works requests consideration and possible action by the Village Board to approve the proposed change order work as set forth in the submitted documents established by Public Works and Christopher Burke Engineering.

Budget / Finance:

Funding is available in the approved FY19 Capital Projects Budget in the amount of \$130,641.03. Also, we recently received approval notification that ComEd reserved an incentive amount of \$42,616.70 for our current LED Street Lighting Replacement-Phase 2 Project as well.



Staff Direction Request:

- 1. Approve a change order to the existing contract with Meade Electric, McCook, IL, for the FY19 LED Street Lighting Replacement Phase 2 Project in the amount of \$106,925.00.
- 2. Direct staff as necessary.
