DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY AND DISASTER


WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the office of the Village President by Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6, and Section 31.012 of the Tinley Park Village Code, I, Jacob C. Vandenberg, President ("Mayor") of the Village of Tinley Park ("Village") do hereby declare that a Local State of Emergency and Disaster exists as of this date, March 20, 2020, and shall continue as set forth in this Village Declaration until the Village Board meeting of April 7, 2020 or until such time as the Village Board shall conduct its next meeting after April 7, 2020, whichever comes first; and

WHEREAS, This Declaration is due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 disease in the State of Illinois ("State"). State of Illinois Governor JB Pritzker issued a disaster declaration on March 9, 2020 due to the COVID-19 disease outbreak in the State and the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the COVID-19 disease outbreak a worldwide global pandemic. Furthermore, Governor Pritzker enacted a "Shelter in Place" order effective March 21, 2020 at 5:00 PM CST until April 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the emergency is the spread of the COVID-19 disease in the Village and extraordinary measures must be taken to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, this Declaration of Local State of Emergency shall be filed with the Village Clerk as soon as practicable; and

NOW, THEREFORE I, JACOB VANDENBERG, whose name is signed to this Declaration, being first duly sworn, signed and executed this Declaration of Local State of Emergency and Disaster, and that I signed willingly, and that I executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.
