## NOTICE Public Hearing Offer

The Village of Tinley Park is providing this notice for the proposed 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 179<sup>th</sup> Street Multi-use Path Extension Federal-Aid Improvement Project. This path extension is located between the south 183<sup>rd</sup> Street trail and north 179<sup>th</sup> Street trail. The Village of Tinley Park cordially invites any interested person who desires that a public hearing should be held for this project to request a hearing by contacting Public Works, during a 30-day window. The 30-day contact period is scheduled to start Wednesday, September 1, 2021, and end Thursday, September 30, 2021. A public hearing will be held if sufficient interest is demonstrated.

During this time period, the Village is also seeking public comments on the effects that the proposed improvements will have on the Canine Campus Dog Park. The Canine Campus Dog Park, which is under the jurisdiction of the Tinley Park – Park District, is subject to protection under Section 4(f) of the US Department of Transportation Act of 1966. For the 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 179<sup>th</sup> Street Multi-use Path Extension project, the Village intends to seek a Section 4(f) "de minimis" impact finding from the Federal Highway Administration based on a determination that the project will not adversely affect the features, attributes, or activities that qualify the Canine Campus Dog Park for protection under Section 4(f).

Effects of the 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 179<sup>th</sup> Street Multi-use Path Extension project on the Canine Campus Dog Park will include a 10' wide asphalt path that borders the north section of the fenced in area of the park. Mitigation will include minimizing the project limits by utilizing the maximum allowable side slopes adjacent to the multi-use path. Detailed documentation describing the impacts and mitigation associated with the effects of the 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 179<sup>th</sup> Street Multi-use Path Extension project on the Canine Campus Dog Park is available at Village Hall from 8:30 am – 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday. A Project Development Report has been prepared for this project and is also available for viewing and inspection by the public at Village Hall. If additional information is desired, please contact Public Works.
