Currently, 82.0% of the 21,875 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 13.4%, renter occupied; and 4.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 22,410 housing units in the area - 83.0% owner occupied, 13.4% renter occupied, and 3.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is -1.07%. Median home value in the area is \$252,961, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.26% annually to \$282,831.
