## Village seeks PPE donations

The Village will accept PPE donations from 1 to 3 p.m. and 5 to 7 p.m. Mondays through Saturdays at the Tinley Park Helipad, 7800 W. 183rd St., directly adjacent to the Tinley Park Police Department.

Needed supplies include:

- Masks (N-95, earloop, surgical)
- Gowns (isolation, non-descript)
- Gloves (nitrile, sterile, surgical)
- Eye Protection (face shields, goggles)
- Infection control kits
- Hand sanitizer (any size)
- Disinfectant wipes (any size)
- Thermometers (forehead only)

All items should be in the manufacturer's original packaging and unopened. Unfortunately, the Village cannot accept open products or homemade items. Thank you for your consideration.
