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The Tinley Park Fire Department would like to remind residents to change the batteries in their smoke alarms at the same time they turn their clocks back one hour on Sunday, Nov. 1 for Daylight Saving Time.

Smoke alarms are a key part of a home fire escape plan. When there is a fire, smoke spreads fast. Working smoke alarms give you early warning so you can get outside quickly.
