Please also remember to shovel the sidewalks near your home, especially if you live near schools or other high-trafficked areas. Please be reminded that per Village ordinance, vehicles cannot be parked on any Village street when there is two inches or more of snowfall. Also please remember per ordinance not to throw snow into the street. This will greatly assist the Public Works Department with plowing the streets.
