Metra makes changes to Rock Island Line

Metra on Monday will make minor changes to the schedules of three trains on its Rock Island Line to Joliet in response to customer feedback, to improve on-time performance and to provide transfer opportunities. Changes include:

- Beginning March 22, Metra will adjust inbound Train 706's schedule so that it departs Joliet five minutes later at 7:35 a.m. and arrives at LaSalle Street Station at 8:35 a.m. This change will improve spacing between trains, thereby reducing delays due to congestion.
- In response to feedback from customers, outbound Train 611 will now depart LaSalle Street Station 15 minutes later at 3:25 p.m. and arrive at Blue Island/Vermont Street at 4:05 p.m.
- Outbound Train 411 will now depart LaSalle Street Station five minutes later at 3:45 p.m. This new schedule will better enable passengers on Train 611, who board at intermediate stations, to transfer to Train 411 at Blue Island/Vermont Street.
