Officer Ella French was shot and killed, her partner Officer Carlos Yanez was severely injured, and Officer Joshua Blas is suffering emotional trauma after witnessing the incident.

Books are available at Tinley Park Village Hall, 16250 S. Oak Park Ave., and at the Tinley Park Police Department, 7850 W. 183rd St. Village Hall is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, and the Police Department is open 24/7.

Once the books are filled, Tinley Park Police Chief Matthew Walsh will present them to the Chicago Police Department.
