# IDENTITY THEFT



## If Your Identity Is Stolen:

Flag your credit reports and call a nationwide credit reporting company and ask for a fraud alert on your credit report. The company you call must contract the other two Credit Bureaus so they can put fraud alerts on your files. An initial fraud alert is good for 90 days.
