



2018 Music in the Plaza Food and Beverage Vendor Opportunities

Applications are now available for Downtown Tinley businesses interested in becoming a food and beverage vendor for the Music in the Plaza Concert Series. The concerts draw between 3,000 to 4,000 per night and are free to attend, family friendly, and highly popular. Bands will include country, classic rock, '80s, '90s, and current pop and rock music.

Potential vendors are being offered a combined food and beverage option. Selected vendors must have a Tinley Park liquor license or partner with another Tinley Park business that possesses one. A special event liquor license will also be required from both the Village and the State. Each vendor must supply a kid-friendly item on the menu. Handing out bounce-back coupons for your business is encouraged.

Vendor's vehicles will only be allowed inside the event perimeter until 6:15 p.m. at which point all equipment and deliveries must be hand delivered. Vendors are supplied with a designated space and electricity and are responsible for their own set-up including tables and lights. A pop-up tent and visible signage identifying the vendor are required. Vendors must be operational by 6:45 p.m.

The Food and Beverage vendor fee is \$300 per concert. Only one Food and Beverage Vendor and one Snack Vendor will be approved for each concert. Concerts will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, taking into account preferred dates. **A total of four Food and Beverage Vendors will be chosen and will be assigned two concerts each.** If there are still openings after May 1st, additional requested dates will be considered.

If you are interested in becoming a vendor, please complete the included Vendor Agreement. Payment will be requested once your date has been confirmed and must be received before June 5th. In the event that a concert is canceled before 6 p.m., the vendor fee will be refunded.

Food and Beverage Vendors must sell event friendly food and beverages (including water, pop, beer and other approved liquor). At least one kid-friendly item must be on the menu. Vendors must obtain a one-day liquor license from the Village and the State. Restaurants without a liquor license may make arrangements to partner with a bar or restaurant that has one. Only one Food and Beverage Vendor and one Snack Vendor will be accepted for each concert. A total of four Food and Beverage Vendors will be chosen and **will be assigned two concerts each**. Please mark your requested dates below and indicate first, second and third choices accordingly. Dates will be assigned on a first come first served basis. Please note that each vendor must commit to the two concerts assigned to them or they forfeit all concert dates.
