November 25, 2020 Special City Council Meeting

The special emergency meeting was called to order at 1 p.m. at City Hall. Answering roll call were Mayor Joe Lutz via phone, Aldermen Randy Clifford, Mark Hampton, Don Basinger and Mike Kelley. City Clerk Jennifer Schmidt were also present.

Mayor Lutz called the special meeting to discuss the health insurance plan that was approved at the Nov. 2 meeting. It was determined that the plan presented to the council and the plan provided were not the same; no out of pocket maximum, no coverage for pregnancy, rehabilitation services, and home health. Kelley moved to rescind the contract the council previously approved with Twin Lakes Insurance agent Cory Matt, based on the summary of benefits not matching the plan proposed to the council. Seconded by Hampton, roll call vote: Clifford, yes; Hampton, yes; Basinger, yes; Kelley, yes.

The council reviewed a UHC plan presented by Jo Snodgrass, Wallstreet Insurance, with a \$3,000 deductible and took note of the three plans Twin Lakes agent Cory Matt presented with Humana. Kelley moved to approve the United Health Care Choice Plus Gold 3000 for the 12/1 employee health insurance renewal. Seconded by Basinger, roll call vote: Kelley, yes; Basinger, yes; Hampton, yes; Clifford, yes.

Mayor Lutz suggested closing city hall to the public due to the rise in COVID 19 cases in the community. Kelley moved to close city hall to the public effective November 30, 2020. Seconded by Basinger; roll call vote: Hampton, yes; Basinger, yes; Kelley, yes; Clifford, no.

Basinger moved to adjourn. Seconded by Kelley, roll call vote: Clifford, yes; Hampton, yes; Basinger, yes; Kelley, yes. The meeting adjourned at 1:06 p.m.
