**1. Call to order, roll call**

The January 7, 2020 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rick Delawder. Also in attendance were: Commission Member Tony Amato; Police Director Bill Hayden, Deputy Chief Joe Maranowicz, Detective Commander Roy Selvik, Attorney David Freeman, and Mary Heneghan.

Representing Johnny B's were John Bocian and George Lykouretzos.

**2. Approval of the minutes of the November 5, 2019 meeting**

Commission Member Amato made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Chairman Delawder. Motion approved unanimously.

**3. Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Pappous Inc. d/b/a Johnny B's at 705 S. Addison Road, Class "E"**

Chairman Delawder read the Public Hearing Notice and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicants.

Mr. Bocian stated that he has 26 years of experience in the restaurant business, serving as general manager for his cousins' restaurants, which did include alcohol service. He is requesting to serve beer and wine at this location as well. No alcohol will be sold to go, and they will have an ID scanner to verify age. Mr. Bocian stated that they plan to be open Monday through Saturday from 10am to 9pm, and Sunday from 11am to 7pm. They have 9 tables and 8 booths, and plan to serve food to the tables. All employees will be Basset trained. The changes made to the business have simply been cosmetic (replacing counter tops, tables, etc.)

Mr. Lykouretzos stated that he has 40 years of experience in the restaurant and banquet business. He has invested in this new business, which will be managed by Mr. Bocian.

Detective Commander Selvik reported that both background checks came back without any issues. He then explained the Police Department's policies on conducting license / underage

drinking checks at the liquor establishments in town twice a year. He stated that the Police Department likes to have good, positive working relationships with all of the liquor establishments and he encouraged Mr. Bocian to call if he ever had any issues or concerns at this location.

Commission Member Amato made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Chairman Delawder. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mary Heneghan reviewed the next steps of the approval process with the applicant.
