3. Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Dhaliwal Liquor & Wine II Inc. d/b/a Famous Beverages at 70 W. Lake Street, Class "B"

Chairman Delawder read the Public Hearing Notice and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicant.

Commission Member Amato asked if this was a new location, and Mr. Dhaliwal responded that this will be his second store here in Addison – he owns Famous Liquors Xpress on Fullerton, and this second store will be located in Green Meadows Shopping Center. Mr. Dhaliwal stated that he has been the owner of Famous Liquors Xpress for three years, and that he truly enjoys living and owning a business here in Addison. He expressed his appreciation to the Commission and Village staff members for their support and assistance.

Director Hayden commended the applicant on his work ethic and his dedication to working hard to achieve his goal of opening multiple liquor stores here in Addison.

Detective Commander Selvik reported that the background check came back without any issues.

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Amato. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mary Heneghan reviewed the next steps of the approval process with the applicant.

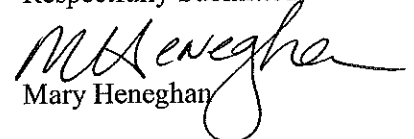
