1. **Call to order, roll call**

The May 3, 2022 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rick Delawder. Also in attendance were: Commission Members Tony Amato, Carol Cesario and Mike Hartnett; Village Manager Joe Maranowicz, Police Director Bill Hayden, Deputy Chief Roy Selvik; Attorney David Freeman and Attorney Patrick Miner; and Mary Heneghan.

Representing Ilios 22 Inc. d/b/a Gametime 190 were Soula Iliopoulos, Nikki Iliopoulos, and Attorney Robert Kaplan.

Chairman Delawder asked for a moment of silence in memory of Commission Member Sandi Milazzo.

2. **Approval of the minutes of the January 5 2022 meeting**

Commission Member Amato made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Commission Member Hartnett. Motion approved unanimously.

3. **Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Ilios 22 Inc. d/b/a Gametime 190 located 190 N. Swift Road, Suite B, Class "A"**

Mary Heneghan swore in the applicants. Attorney Kaplan stated that he is representing Soula and Nikki Iliopoulos. Soula stated that her family has 40 years of experience in the restaurant business. She currently manages Caps Sports Bar & Grill in Villa Park. They plan to do some minor construction in the food prep area at this establishment here in Addison. They will offer a limited menu, with mainly snack foods. Their hours will be 11am to 1am Sundays through Thursdays, and 11am to 2am on Fridays and Saturdays. Soula stated that they do plan to apply for video gaming machines, and they will add TV's so that people can watch sporting events. Nikki will be the primary manager of this establishment. All employees will be Bassett trained.

Deputy Chief Selvik stated that there were no issues with the background checks.

Director Hayden stressed the Police Department's goal to establish good working relationships with the liquor establishments here in town, and he encouraged the applicants to contact the Police Department any time they need assistance. He also explained that the Police Department

will conduct compliance checks two times a year. Lastly, he encouraged the applicants to card everyone.

Commission Member Cesario made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Hartnett. The motion was approved unanimously. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicants.

Village Manager Maranowicz stated that the current owner of this establishment has paid for the liquor license for the month of May; so if the Village Board approves this new liquor license, the applicants will have to pay for the remaining 5 months of the renewal fee for the current licensing period.
