1. **Call to order, roll call**

The November 7, 2023 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Acting Chairman Tony Amato. Also in attendance were: Commission Members Carol Cesario, Mike Hartnett and Fred Yanez; Liquor Commissioner Rich Veenstra, Village Manager Joe Maranowicz, Deputy Chief Roy Selvik, Detective Sergeant Pat Glomb, Attorney Patrick Miner, and Mary Heneghan.

Representing Paddock Lounge was Chardae Pliske.

2. **Approval of the minutes of the September 12, 2023 meeting**

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Commission Member Cesario. Motion approved unanimously.

3. **Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Paddock Lounge LLC d/b/a Paddock Lounge at 2381 W. Army Trail Road, Class "D"**

The Public Hearing notice was read, and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicant.

Ms. Pliske explained that K1 Speed is separating the food and beverage portion of their establishment into a separate business at all 63 of their locations across the country. Food and beverage sales only amount to approximately 7% of the overall business at K1. Ms. Pliske serves as the Operations Manager for this establishment, and is Basset certified. She explained the "wrist-band" technique strategy used to identify racers to ensure they do not consume alcohol while racing. Overall business operations will remain the same.

Deputy Chief Selvik stated that there were no issues with the background check, and that this establishment has not had any liquor related violations. He explained that compliance checks will continue, and he advised Ms. Pliske to ensure that staff continues to check ID's.

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Yanez. The motion was approved unanimously. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicant.


