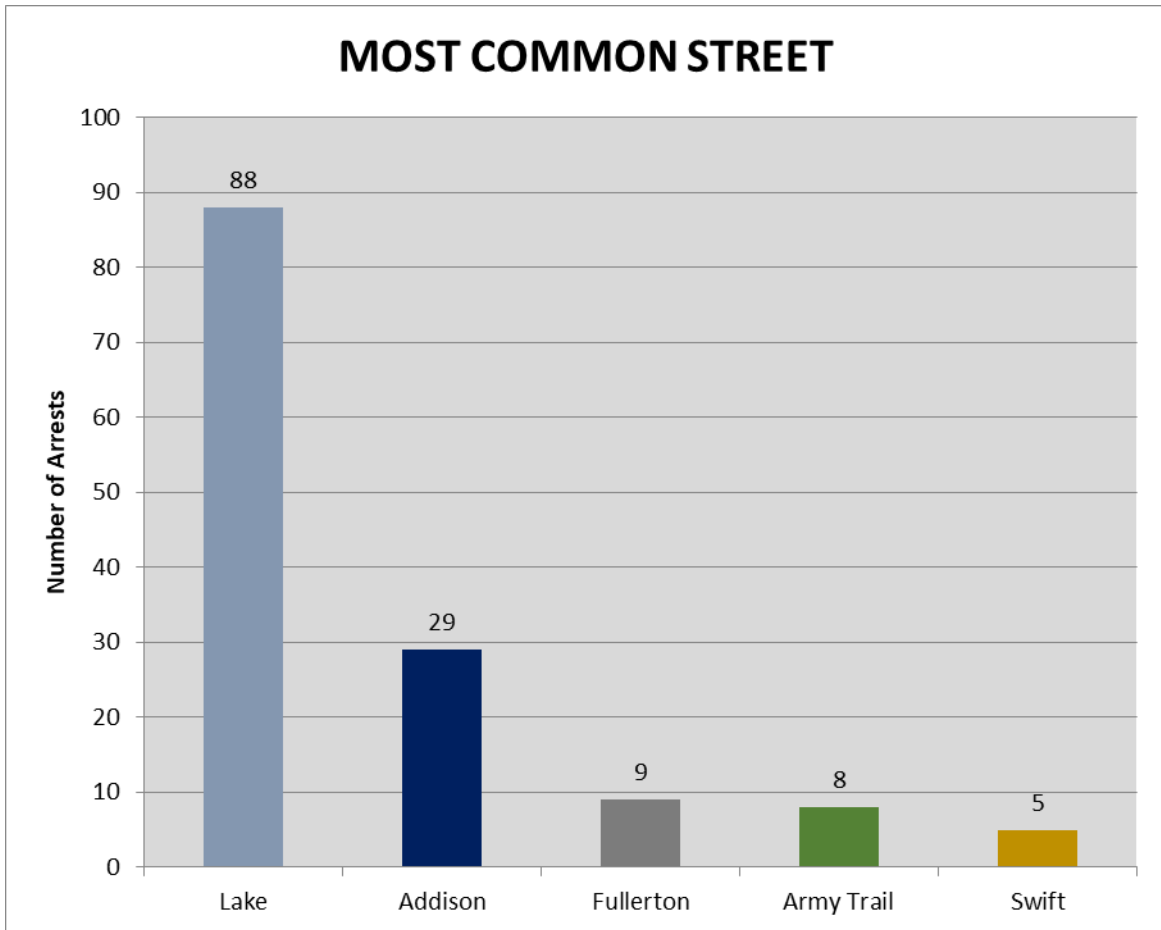
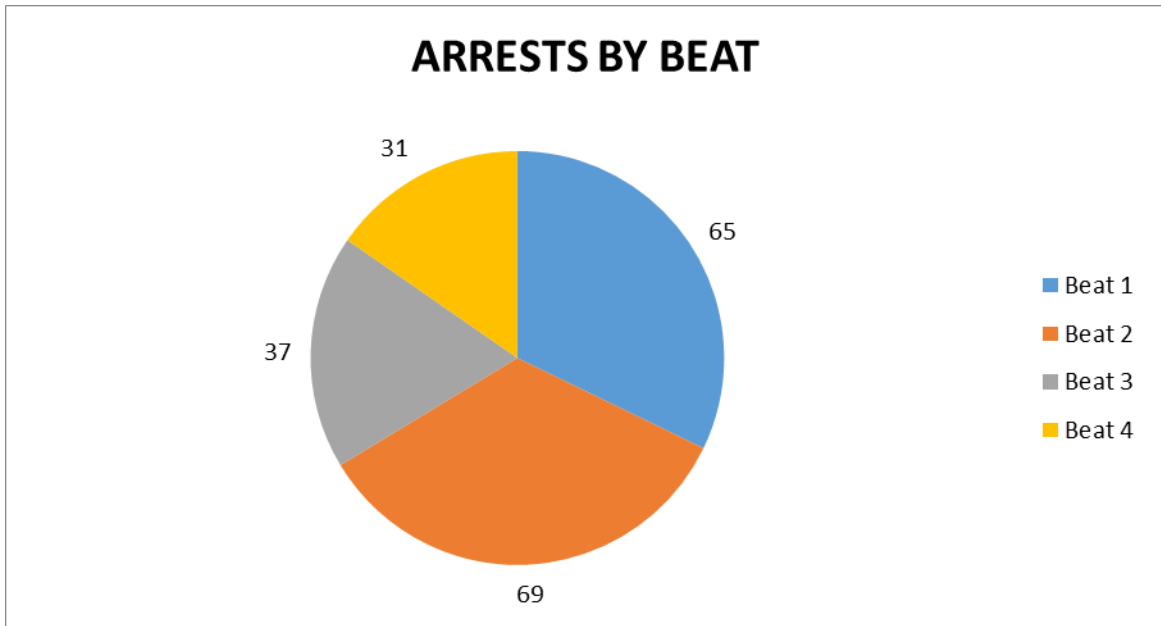
Attached are the DUI statistics for the 2023 Annual Report. Analysis of the data follows:

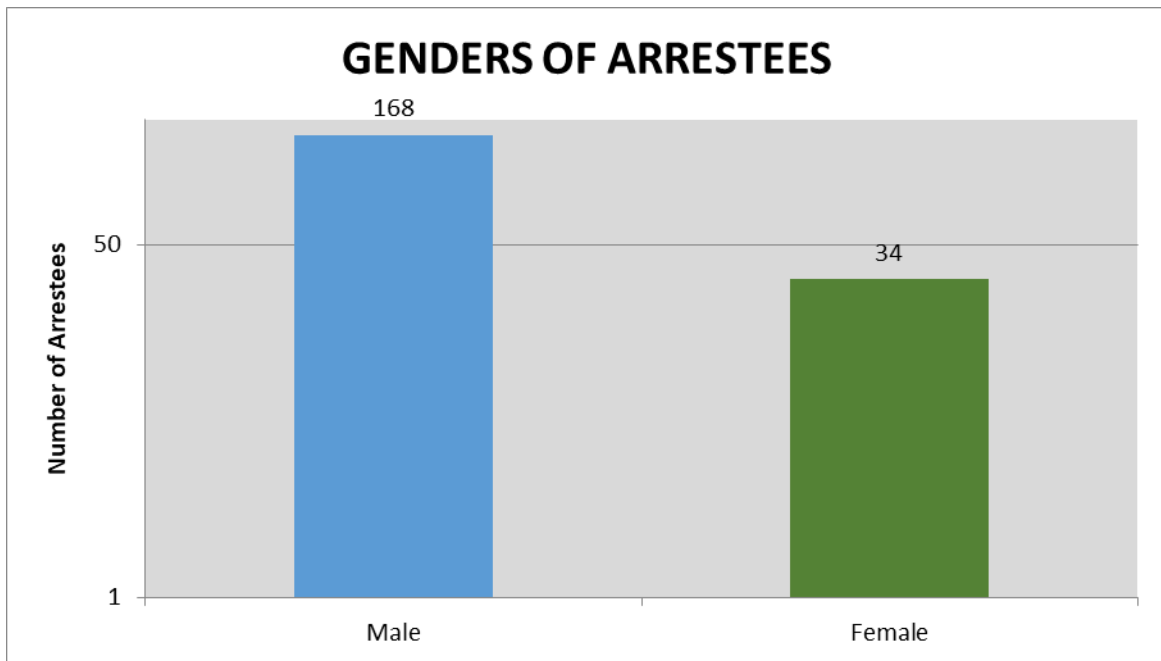
1. Total arrests (202) were significantly higher than 2022 arrests (173).
2. The number of offenders in each age category remains consistent with previous years. The total number of males arrested (168) is still significantly higher than females (34). The predominant offenders were in the 21 – 30 age group and the 31 – 40 age group, both with (66) arrests.
3. Total DUI crashes with arrests (36) decreased by 4 from the 2022 DUI crash arrests (40).
4. Injury DUI crashes (13) increased by 7 from the 2022 injury crashes (6).
5. There was (0) fatal DUI crashes in 2022.
6. Offenders reported the following liquor-licensed establishments as to where they were drinking at prior to arrest: American Tap (4), Lorena’s (2), and Venuti’s (2).
7. The most common primary street where an arrest occurred was Lake Street (88).
8. Total arrests made for DUI Drugs (12).

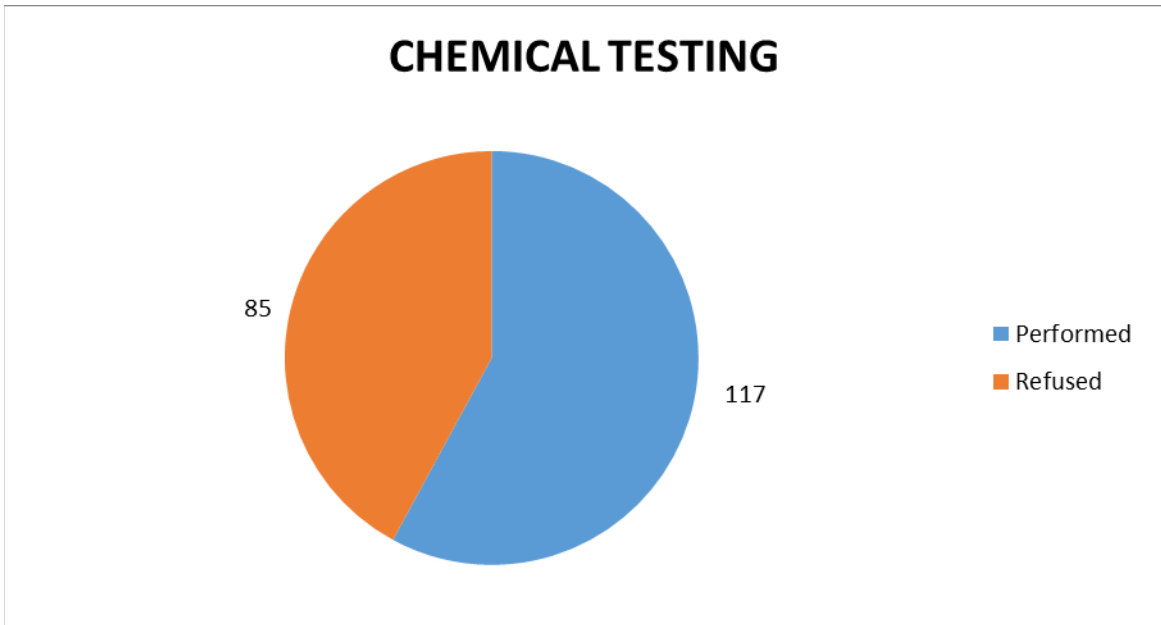
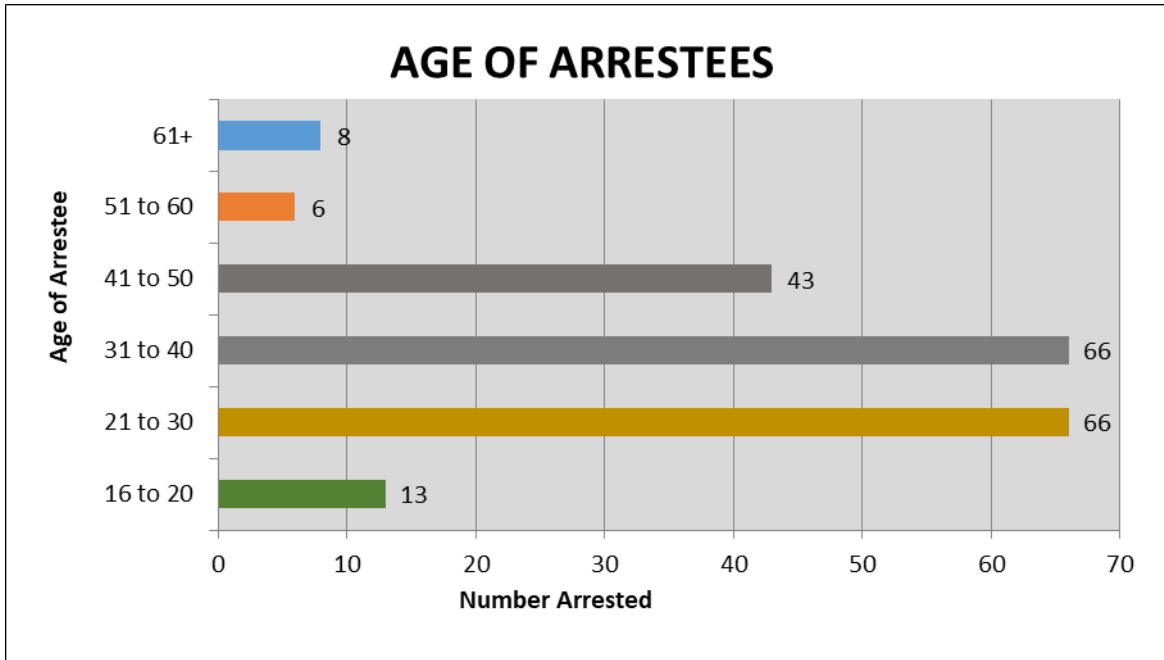

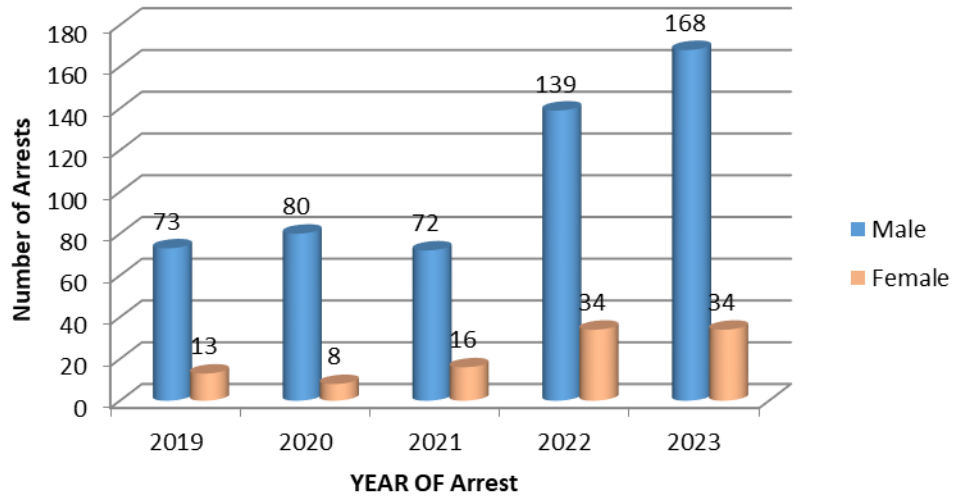
The following is the multi-annual DUI statistics report for the years 2019 through 2023.

1. The average DUI arrests for the five-year comparison are 127.4 DUI arrests per year, with a five-year DUI arrest total of 637.
2. The five-year period shows the total number of males arrested (532) was significantly higher than the number of females arrested (105).
3. The five-year average for DUI crashes with arrests was 32.6, and the five-year average for crashes with injuries was 11 per year. There has been (0) fatalities in the past five years.
