Neighborhood Watch Letter Police Reports by Geographical Area:

North Area (north of Lake Street)

Cruz, Angel M. of Addison was charged with Domestic Battery. Cruz pushed victims several times in the chest. Cruz was transported to the DuPage County Jail.

Orozco, Fernando of Addison was charged with No Valid Driver's License and Unlawful Possession of Controlled Substance. Orozco was operating a vehicle without a valid license and was found with a controlled substance.

Carreno, Jose A. of Addison was charged with Reckless Driving/Driving While License Suspended/Operating Uninsured Motor Vehicle/Failure to Give Aid or Information/Driving on the Wrong Side of the Road/Improper Turn/Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident.
