## Neighborhood Watch Letter Police Reports by Geographical Area

### North Area (north of Lake Street)

Alfonso Cifuentes-Ramos of Addison was arrested on a warrant. Officer responded to the Elk Grove Village Police Department to transport and process Cifuentes-Ramos on a warrant out of the Addison Police Department for driving under the influence, resisting or obstructing a peace officer, leaving the scene of an accident, failure to give aid or information, failure to report to the police and failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.
