*June 23, 2023, Anthem, AZ* – The ACC Board of Directors held a special board meeting on June 21, 2023, to interview candidates for the open board seat vacated by Director Chilesa Ready (Parkside) who resigned in April 2023. With five out of six board member votes, Ms. Cody Curl was appointed to represent Parkside on the ACC Board of Directors until April 2024.
