**Calling For Committee Members:  
Community Committee to Study Anthem Amenities**

*July 7, 2023, Anthem, AZ* – The Anthem Community Council is delighted to announce the establishment of a special committee to recommend policies related to the Council’s recreational facilities and amenities. With the growth in the surrounding area, Anthem’s amenities are seeing more use. We invite passionate and dedicated individuals from parts of the community to serve as committee members and actively contribute to shaping the future of our community.

The purposes of the committee are outlined below:

1. Examine the most effective current and future use of all amenities, as well as amenity programs and activities, consistent with the Council-approved Strategic Pillars
2. Examine resident and non-resident usage of Council amenities and the impact of changing the status quo
3. Examine whether or not access to certain amenities should be regulated. If so, to what degree and how
4. Examine various cost recovery methods for resident and non-resident usage of Council amenities
5. Examine whether or not Council amenities should be reservable, by whom and the rate

We are looking for committed individuals who possess a strong sense of community, diverse perspectives, and a passion for driving positive change. Participants need to be Anthem residents. There are six seats for residents including two for high school students. ACC is looking for a diverse group of voices and points of view for this committee to accomplish its task.

As a committee member, your insights will assist with determining the most effective current and future use of all amenities, programs, and activities. The nine-person committee will also include three ACC Council members. Various ACC staffers will serve as ex-officio.

To be considered for a committee member position, interested individuals are encouraged to submit their [application online for a committee seat](#). Applications are only being accepted online and are due July 23. Applicants are requested to include a brief statement outlining their interest in serving on the committee and their relevant experience or skills.

At the end of their work, the committee, chaired by a board member, will present to the Board during a regular meeting their findings and recommendations. The committee will also provide a written report. The first meeting will be August 10 and work will conclude by May 2024.

We extend our gratitude in advance to all those who express their interest in joining this vital committee. Your commitment and dedication to the betterment of Anthem are deeply appreciated. Together, we will ensure that Anthem's amenities continue to flourish and meet the needs of our residents.
