**Anthem Spring Go Green Recycling April 15**

March 29, 2023, Anthem, AZ – Anthem residents are invited to attend the Go Green Recycling event on Saturday April 15, 8-11am, at the Community Park lower parking lot entering from North Freedom Way to West Whitman Drive and exit onto to N. Gavilan Peak Pkwy. This event is only open to Anthem residents.

Participants must provide one form of Anthem residency identification and must be in line prior to 10:45am. Republic Services with assistance from ProShred, Safety-Kleen, Westech Recyclers, Lighting Resources LLC, Maricopa County Sheriff's Office, and other community partners make the event possible for Anthem residents to properly dispose of common household materials.

Saint Vincent de Paul will be onsite accepting donations of non-perishable food items, cases of bottled water, empty prescription bottles, new undergarments, socks and school supplies, new toothbrushes/toothpaste and other toiletries, diapers, books, new/gently used luggage, clothing, shoes, blankets, and toys.

Approved recycling materials include, but are not limited to, electronics, batteries, small kitchen appliances, bulk materials, cardboard, personal documents, residential paint (five-gallon limit), household hazardous waste, and prescription/non-prescription drugs.

Unaccepted items include Freon, tires, medical sharps, pressurized tanks, commercial paint and hazardous liquids, ammunition and any explosives.
