When the expansion is complete, over 3000 pavers will have been laid in the Circle of Honor to commemorate veterans. Veteran pavers make wonderful birthday, holiday, Mother’s and Father’s Day gifts. Order now and be among the first veterans in the new Circle of Honor.

Who can be honored? Any veteran, living or deceased, those who served in the past and those who serve today. We honor veterans regardless of rank or rate, how long they served, whether they served in times of peace or times of war. The veterans don’t have to live in Anthem or AZ. We have honored veterans from almost every US state and three allied nations.

How do I order a veteran paver?

Or, the paver form may be downloaded, printed and mailed with payment. [Click here](#).

What information do I need for the inscribed paver?

Each line is permitted 22 characters, including spaces. There are no exceptions. There are three lines total.

Line One: Name as you would like it to appear on the paver.

Second Line: Military rank or rate. We prefer the rank/rate is spelled out vs abbreviations. First Lieutenant, Colonel, Admiral, Petty Officer...

Third Line: Military Branch (abbreviated), space, year entered the military, dash, year left the military. USA USMC USN USAF USSF USCG
Example: USCG 1976-1996

Additional Options

- Combat veterans: Military Branch (abbreviated), space, War/Operation, year entered the military, dash, year left the military. Operations are abbreviated: OIF, OEF, WOT, ODS, etc.
Example: USMC OEF 2001-2022
Example: USA Korea 1951-1955
- If POW: USAF POW 1967-1985
- If KIA: Use the date on which the veteran was killed in action:
Example: USMC KIA 3-24-1967
- Active duty: Leave second year blank, unless known for future.
Example: USA OEF 2001-
- Significant Medals: Add to second or third line:
Example: USA Vietnam PH 1961-68
Example: Major PH 2BS
