Residential Curbside Recycling & Waste Services (east of I-17)

Republic Services® appreciates the opportunity to serve your community.

As an Anthem resident, you will receive residential curbside services for recycling and waste one time each per week. Your scheduled service day is determined by your service area. Please see the 2024 area map for your curbside recycling and waste service schedule to determine your scheduled day.



Light blue lid = recycling
Black lid = waste

Please place carts on the street the night prior to your collection day or by 6 a.m. on your assigned collection day. For safe and efficient service, please place the carts in the street with the wheels touching the curb. The carts should not be placed on the sidewalk, and you should allow 4 feet between your recycling and waste carts. You will start seeing our new Republic Services branded blue carts in your neighborhoods for all new deliveries or exchanges. We will continue our services on the previous colors: green for recycling and tan for waste.

Quarterly rates for once-weekly recycling and waste pickup

Total quarterly invoice = \$59.31 (January 2024 - December 2024)

Additional services are still available upon request and include:

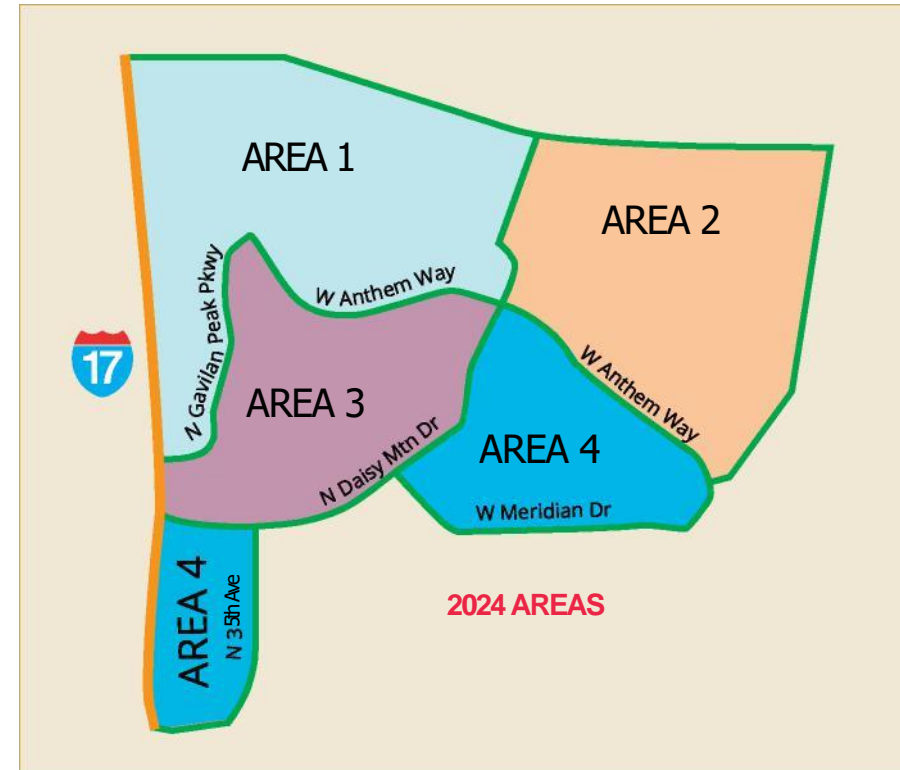
- New account setup at \$0
- Cart delivery at \$0
- Cart repair or replacement at \$0 (limited to one time per year, per cart)
- Extra waste cart at \$15.00 per quarter
- Bulk pickup that is **in addition** to the regularly scheduled bulk service will be an additional \$125 charge that will be the responsibility of the resident. This additional pickup will be serviced on the same Friday as your scheduled bulk service. **For efficiency, this service must be paid and scheduled in advance of your normal scheduled bulk service day.**
- Additional service (unscheduled) at \$15 per one 95-gallon cart
- Vacation hold request at no charge. Resident must be gone longer than 10 days, but not longer than 6 months. Account will receive prorated credit on next invoice for any service charges during vacation hold period.
- Walk-up service at \$75 per quarter (with approval)

Service fees are paid directly to Republic Services and are not part of ACC or HOA dues. In order to receive service, new residents must set up an account by calling Republic Services at 602.237.2078 or 800.833.4316 or by visiting our website at [RepublicServices.com](https://www.RepublicServices.com).

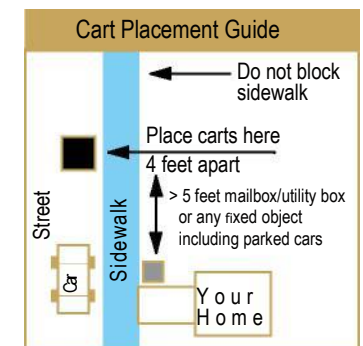

Residential Bulk Waste

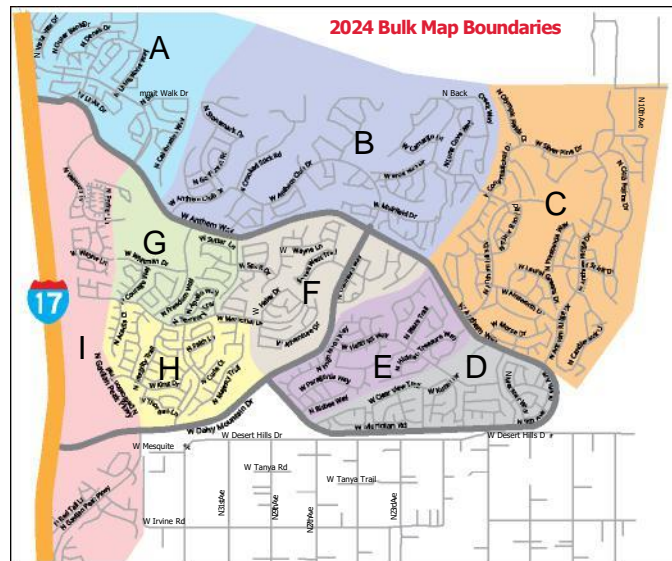
Bulk waste will be collected every other month. Items must be out no later than 6 a.m.

Each area will have bulk collection seven times per year. Please place bulk material curbside no earlier than the weekend prior to and **no later than 6 a.m.** on your scheduled bulk collection day. Below is the 2024 schedule for the new bulk collection days.

Bulk Waste Guidelines

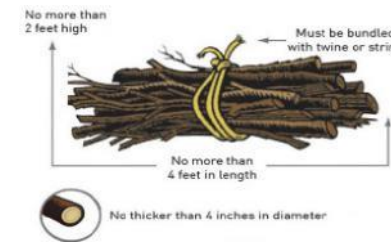
Bulk waste is material that cannot be placed in the waste cart, like furniture, some appliances and large amounts of vegetation.

- Not to exceed 6 cubic yards (4'h x 6'w x 6'd)
- Must be neatly stacked, bagged, boxed and/or tied



Acceptable Bulk Waste Items

- Furniture
- Items too large to fit in the waste cart
- Some appliances (Freon® must be removed)
- Vegetation/branches per below guidelines:
- No more than 2 Ft high, 4 Ft wide, and **MUST BE BUNDLED** with twine or string



Unacceptable Bulk Waste Items

- Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, oil)
- Loose grass, leaves, weeds, twigs and hedge clippings that are not bagged or tied
- Bricks, concrete, dirt and rocks, tile, asphalt, roofing or similar materials
- Construction material in excess of 25 pounds or longer than 4 feet generated by a resident; any construction materials generated by a contractor
- Metal, rebar and fence posts
- Tires, rims or automobile parts
- Untapped glass, such as windows, shower doors, patio doors, mirrors, etc.*
- Any appliances containing Freon®

*Glass is accepted as long as it is taped to ensure it doesn't break. This is a safety concern for the Anthem community and the Republic Services employees.

Bulk Waste

Must be placed at least 5' from any fixed object:

- Utility pole
- Cable box
- Mailbox
- Water meter
- Parked car, etc.

Vegetation/ Branches

- No more than 4' in length and no larger than 24" in diameter
- Must be bundled and tied with wire or heavy twine

Acceptable Items:

- Electronics, light bulbs and batteries
- Household items for donation
- Cardboard, paper and plastic
- Paints and stains (up to 5 gallons)
- Household hazardous waste

The event hours are 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. Residents must be in line by 10:45 a.m. to participate. Vehicles must enter from Whitman Drive and exit onto Gavilan Peak Pkwy. Proof of Anthem residency required. Events will be in the spring and fall.

The fall event is scheduled for Saturday April 13th 2024, and the spring event is scheduled for Saturday October 26th.

Recycling Cart Collection Guidelines



- Rinse plastic containers, steel and tin cans to remove liquid and food, then dry. This will help avoid attracting flies and other pests.
- Leave lids on if they are made of recyclable materials.
- Break down or cut up large cardboard boxes before placing in cart. This prevents material from wedging inside the cart, restricting contents from being disposed.
- Place junk mail or loose papers in brown paper bags. This prevents spills.
- Ensure recyclables are empty, clean and dry.
- Ensure cart lid is closed before placing out for collection.
- Ensure that the cart lid opens toward the collection vehicle.
- Deliver large pieces of cardboard that do not fit into your recycling cart to your nearest drop-off recycling dumpster.



- Place your recycling cart near parked cars, light poles, mailboxes or other obstacles that could hinder collection.
- Leave your recycling cart at the curb after 6 p.m. if it has been serviced.
- Stack items on or near your carts.
- Leave inserts in chipboard boxes.
- Use your recycling cart for trash.
- Swap carts with your neighbor.
- Place yard clippings and other green organic material in your recycling cart.

Acceptable

Newspapers, magazines, phone books and all other inserts

Other Paper Materials:

Computer and writing paper, file folders, paper bags, junk mail, shredded paper in clear bags

Glass (clean):

Food and beverage containers only

Aluminum & Metal:

Tin and food cans, foil food wrappers

Plastic (clean):

Plastic containers with code symbols 1, 2 and 5; 2-liter soda bottles; detergent bottles; milk jugs; clear food containers

Cardboard/Chipboard:

Corrugated boxes, shoe boxes, soda/beer boxes, dry food boxes such as cereal, cake mix and cracker boxes

Unacceptable

We will be unable to service your recycling cart if there are non-recyclable materials in it, so remember, "If it's not on the list, please resist!"

- Wax-covered containers
- Light bulbs
- Pottery
- Window glass or mirrors
- Plastic bags
- Polystyrene foam
- Packing peanuts
- 5-gallon buckets
- Facial or toilet paper
- Paper towels/napkins
- Diapers
- Hazardous waste
- Solid waste
- Thermal fax paper or receipts
- Pet food bags
- Hardback or paperback books

2024 Anthem Holiday Service Schedule

Memorial Day, Monday May 27, 2024, and Labor Day Monday September 2, 2024

- For the labor day and memorial day holiday, service will have a 1 day delay.
- Bulk Services scheduled for Friday May 31st, will be serviced Saturday June 1st
- Bulk service scheduled for Friday September 6th, will be serviced Saturday September 7th

Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 28, 2023

- For the Thanksgiving holiday week, services scheduled for Thursday and Friday will be serviced the following day.
- Bulk services scheduled for Friday, November 29, 2024, will be serviced Saturday, November 30, 2024.

Christmas Day, Wednesday, December 25, 2024, and New Years' Day, Wednesday, January 1, 2025

- For Christmas day holiday week and New Year's Day holiday week, services scheduled for Wednesday will be serviced the following day.
- Bulk Services scheduled for Friday December 27th, 2024, will be serviced Saturday December 28th 2024, and Bulk services scheduled for Friday January 3rd will be serviced on Saturday January 4th
- Services Scheduled for Wednesday December 25th will be serviced on Thursday December 26th, and Services scheduled for Wednesday January 1st, 2025, will be Thursday January 2nd.

Only the listed holidays have a service change
