- **Decorated Pumpkin Display and Contest:** Pumpkins can be dropped off for display on Saturday, Oct. 22, from 10 a.m.-noon at Community Park (tent near Main Pavilion). Entry paperwork, category descriptions, and additional guidelines will be posted online. There is no cost to enter; entries are due Oct. 15 by 5 p.m.
