ANTHEM COMMUNITY COUNCIL ANNOUNCES SEARCH FOR NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Anthem, Ariz. – The Anthem Community Council (ACC) Board of Directors has announced that it will soon begin a search for the community’s next executive director. The national search, which will be conducted through an independent, third-party search firm, is expected to last through the end of 2021.

Previous Board chairman and long-time Anthem resident Terry Mullarkey has been serving in the role of interim executive director since September 2020, when he resigned from his Board position to join the staff. About his service, ACC Board Chairman Bob McKenzie said, “We are grateful to Terry for stepping into the role last year. Alongside the ACC’s executive management team and staff, Terry has carried forward many projects that were underway, so that the new executive director has a solid foundation from which to start.”

Mullarkey’s last day with the Council is July 9. The ACC’s executive management team, along with the Board of Directors, will continue to manage the day-to-day operations while the search is underway.
