

PAINT RECYCLING MADE *easy*

Do you know where to recycle your paint?

There are more than 75 PaintCare sites in Maine where households and businesses can recycle any brand of unwanted paint, stain and varnish all year-round. **(It's free!)** Most locations are paint stores.

Who is PaintCare?

PaintCare is a nonprofit that operates Maine's paint stewardship program on behalf of paint manufacturers. Funding comes from a fee on the sale of new paint as of October 1, 2015. The fee is 35 cents for pints and quarts, 75 cents for 1 gallon cans and \$1.60 for 5 gallon buckets. There is no charge for dropping off leftover paint, no matter how old it is.

All PaintCare sites accept up to 5 gallons per visit (some take more). Please call ahead to confirm business hours and ask if they can accept the type and amount of paint you would like to recycle. Leaking, unlabeled and empty containers are not accepted.
