The City Council met in a special session in the Council Chambers with Mayor William S. Sheckles and the following Councilmen:

The Mayor called the meeting to order. Councilman Buckman introduced Proposed Ordinance B2014 - Mobile Food Vendors and asked for its first reading. City Clerk Bryant read the proposed ordinance in summary. This ordinance creates a new Ordinance which provides for the permitting and regulation of Mobile Food Vendors within the City of Bardstown, by:

- Creating definitions; and
- Requiring permits, and a permit application process, including necessary submissions, review and issuance; and
- Restricting the location and duration for mobile food vending activities.
- Setting conditions for Mobile Food Vending, including General Conditions, Signage, adherence to Health Regulations, and Miscellaneous Regulations; and
- Providing for municipal immunity, indemnity of the City and severability of provisions.

UPON MOTION OF COUNCILMAN ROYALTY, DULY SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN REED AND CARRIED BY A VOTE OF 6 TO 0, PROPOSED ORDINANCE B2014-MOBILE FOOD VENDORS WAS APPROVED ON FIRST READING.
