COMMISSION ASSISTANCE & MENTORING PROGRAM (CAMP)

Due the absence of Mayor Sheckles, **COUNCILMAN WILLIAMS MADE A MOTION TO APPOINT COUNCILMAN SIMPSON AS PRESIDING OFFICER. THE MOTION WAS DULY SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN REED AND CARRIED BY A VOTE OF 4-0.** Councilman Simpson then called the meeting to order and welcomed all to the training session. He then instructed those in attendance that the Council could only address items listed on the agenda.
