

**ORDINANCE NO. 466**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT, CHAPTER 6A UTILITIES – BILLING CHARGES, SECTIONS 6-6A-10 REFUSE COLLECTION – SCHEDULE OF FEES, 1. RESIDENTIAL RATE AND 6-6A-11 REFUSE COLLECTION – LARGE ITEMS AND BULKY RUBBISH, 3. SCHEDULE OF FEES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to add a fee for garbage can replacement and amend the refuse collections schedule of fees for large items and bulky rubbish.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Sections 6-6A-10 Refuse Collection – Schedule of Fees, 1. Residential Rate is hereby edited with the addition of h. and 6-6A-11 Refuse Collection – Large Items and Bulky Rubbish, 3. Schedule of Fees of the Bellevue Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting a subset of that section and substituting the following section in its place:

**ADDITION:**

6-6A-10 Refuse Collection – Schedule of Fees. 1. Residential Rate

- h. City of Bellevue garbage can replacement – in the event a resident moves from their residence and/or causes damage to the City owned garbage can, then the resident will be charged \$60.00 to their City of Bellevue utility invoice.

**SUBSTITUTE:**

6-6A-11 Refuse Collection – Residential Rate and, Large Items and Bulky Rubbish.

3. Schedule of Fees. Each customer requesting large garbage collection service beyond a normal stop shall pay a minimum charge of \$60.00 for up to four (4) cubic yards, plus an additional \$8.10 per cubic yard for any amount over four (4) cubic yards. In addition to this collection service charge, each customer shall pay a disposal fee for each item as follows:
  - a. Tires - \$10.00 drop off or \$20.00 pickup per item plus \$0.30 per pound.
  - b. Appliances - \$10.00 drop off or \$20.00 pickup per item plus \$0.30 per pound - Including, but not limited to, washers, dryers, dishwaters, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, compactors, televisions, & stereos.
  - c. Automotive Batteries - \$10.00 drop off or \$20.00 pickup per item plus \$0.30 per pound.
  - d. Electronic Waste - \$10.00 drop off or \$20.00 pickup per item plus \$0.30 per pound – Including but not limited to computer toners, printers, monitors, televisions, copiers and other E-Waste items.
  - e. Scrap Metal - \$10.00 drop off or \$20.00 pickup per item plus \$0.30 per pound.

SECTION 3. *Repealer*. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. *Severability*. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. *Effective Date*. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
