ORDINANCE NO. 2018-15

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELTON, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD WITHIN SAID CITY ON MAY 5, 2018.

WHEREAS, this City Council duly authorized a General Election to be held in the City of Belton, Texas (the "City") on May 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the returns were considered of the General Election held on the 5th day of May, 2018, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two (2) Councilmembers to serve for a term of two years each, to sit and act as the Mayor and members of the City Council of the City of Belton, Texas, during their respective terms, and it appears from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election, 383 valid and legal votes; that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELTON, TEXAS, that said General Election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that said election was held in accordance with the law, and that Marion Grayson was duly elected Mayor, and Wayne Carpenter and Guy O'Banion were duly elected as Councilmembers, subject to the filing of the Statements of Elected Officer and subject to the taking of their Oaths of Office as provided by the law of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Belton, Texas.

It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body, that the City Clerk posted written notice of this meeting on the bulletin board at City Hall and said notice having been so posted, did remain posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting.
