

## Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Belton will receive bids for the 2018 Water & Wastewater Projects-North East Street and 5th Avenue Water Improvements-2nd Avenue to Penelope Street (CDBG Contract Number 7220021) in Belton, Texas, until 2:00 PM, Thursday, May 26, 2022, at the office of the Belton City Clerk, 333 Water Street, Belton, Texas 76513. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 PM on Thursday, May 26, 2022, in the Main Conference Room at Belton City Hall; 333 Water Street; Belton, Texas 76513.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work (but not limited to) as follows:

1. 14.5 Stations of Right-of-Way Preparation.
2. Trench & Traffic Safety Measures.
3. 1,426 feet of 8-inch C-900 Water Pipe
4. 5 Fire Hydrants with Gate Valves.
5. 30 Water Pipe Appurtenances and Fittings.
6. Water Services.
7. 5,200 Square Yards of Milling and 2-inch HMAC Overlay.

Bid/Contract Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications are on file at Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP at 19 North Main Street; Temple, Texas 76501 and can be obtained beginning on Tuesday, April 26, 2022, by depositing \$75.00 with Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP for each set of documents obtained. The deposit will be refunded if the documents and drawings are returned in good condition within 10 days following the bid opening.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Belton, Texas or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs, and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. The City is an Equal Opportunity Employer. The City strives to attain goals for compliance with Federal Section 3 regulations by increasing opportunities for employment and contracting with Section 3 residents and businesses where feasible.

The City of Belton, Texas reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by City of Belton, Texas, for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held in the City of Belton Public Works Center located at 1502 Holland Road, Belton, Texas 76513 at 10:00 AM on Friday, May 13, 2022. Although this is not a mandatory Pre-Bid Conference, it is highly recommended that all bidders attend.
