

## Request for Proposals

The City of Belton is seeking proposals from professional engineering firms to design the following project:

### S. Connell Street Reconstruction and Drainage Improvements

S. Connell Street is identified as a Major Collector Roadway in the City's Thoroughfare Plan, which calls for 80 feet of Right of Way (ROW), four lanes, standard curb and gutter, and 5-foot sidewalks along both sides. Other project design elements include coordinating the relocation of dry utilities, replacing the existing 8-inch waterline with a new 12-inch waterline, drainage improvements including storm sewer installation and culvert improvements, as well as street light installation, and the replacement of driveways.

Proposals will be received by the City Clerk until 10:00 a.m. on Friday, March 8, 2024, at which time they will be publicly acknowledged. The City of Belton reserves the right to reject any and all submissions, to waive irregularities and/or informalities in any submission, and to make an award in any manner, consistent with law, deemed in the best interest of the City.
