

NOTICE TO PROPOSERS

The City of Belton is accepting sealed proposals for Professional Engineering Services for the Design of the Central Avenue/Spring Street Bridge Project. This is a federally funded project, so special provisions apply to the contract.

The project will consist of (1) removal of the current low water crossing over Nolan Creek, providing a cul-de-sac on Central Avenue/Spring Street, on the west side of the creek, at the location of the low water crossing, and (2) extending Spring Street eastward, building a new elevated bridge and reconnecting with Central Avenue/Spring Street on the east side of Nolan Creek.

A non-mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 7, 2024, at the Public Works Department located at 1502 Holland Road.
