CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	DEADLINE TO FILE CANDIDATE APPLICATION**	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a United States Citizen. 2. Must be a registered voter on the date of the election. 3. Must be a resident of the City of Belton for one (1) year prior to the date of the election. 4. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age. 5. Must not be delinquent on any indebtedness to the City. 6. May not be an employee of the City of Belton. 7. May not hold any other elected public office. 8. Candidates may only file for one office per election. 9. Must not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated; or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote. 10. Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities. 11.
